What is the Catholic Faith in Action Seminar?

It has been said that Pope Saint John Paul (the philosopher) told us what we should do; Pope Benedict (the theologian) explained why; and now Pope Francis (the missionary) is telling us to "go do it."

And what is that "it" we are supposed to do? We are to make disciples of all nations (Mt. 28:19). If we examine the teaching of our popes more closely we will also learn how are we supposed to do it.

Popes John Paul and Benedict popularized the phrase The New Evangelization. This is essentially the original evangelization (sharing the Gospel) but with recognition that everyone needs to be evangelized—including us. We all need to be converted more deeply, to experience what the first disciples experienced at Pentecost—the fire of the Holy Spirit.

Pope Francis challenges us to be Missionary Disciples. Once we have experienced Christ and the Holy Spirit more personally, we have something to share.

When viewed together we see the wisdom of our popes telling us to put our Catholic Faith into Action. And that is what this six-week seminar is designed to accomplish.
